2009 was a very successful year, with our greatest-ever number of opening days, four different exhibitions and a varied range of talks and family activities. The Folly is increasingly being seen as one of our area's top visitor attractions, with plenty of interest for local people as well. In 2010 we shall be celebrating our tenth season since opening the newly-restored building to the public and we intend to make it a memorable anniversary, with many special events throughout the year. Our first exhibition, 'A Malham Family of Painters', opens on 30 March and includes work by three generations of the same family of artists: Katharine Holmes, her mother Philippa and her grandmother, Constance Pearson. Alongside their work, we shall be mounting displays illustrating life in Malhamdale, especially during the war years, using many of Constance's letters and family possessions.
